Earth Day!

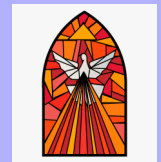

Pets: 12 dogs 10 of which are from the streets of Mexico

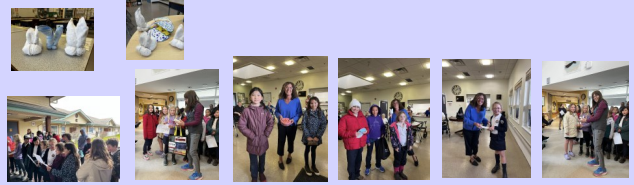

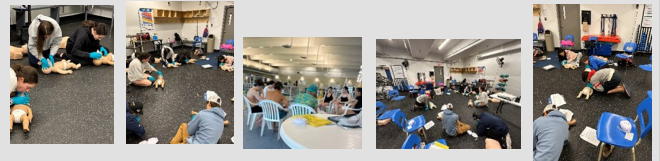

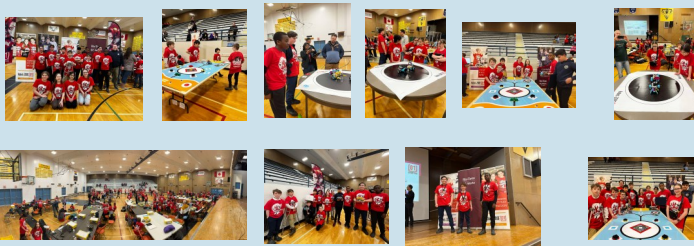
Grade 3 and 4 visited Delta King and Multi-Level Care to sing and bring the residents Easter gifts.
