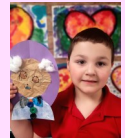
Ash Wednesday

Staff and students attended Mass on Wednesday. **Ash Wednesday** is the first day of **Lent**, a 40-day season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving .

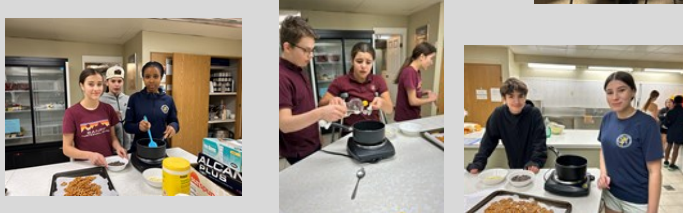
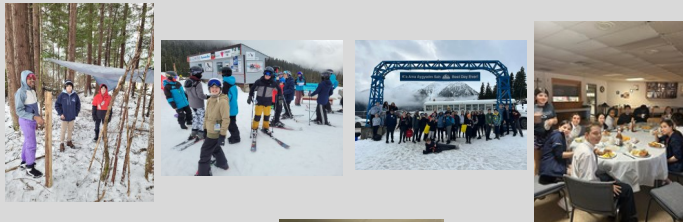
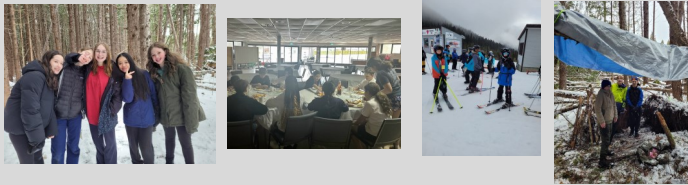
